

ALUMNI FEEDBACK FORM

Alumni feedback is important because it can help the university to improve its programs and services. The feedback form can be used to identify areas where the university is excelling and areas where improvement is needed.

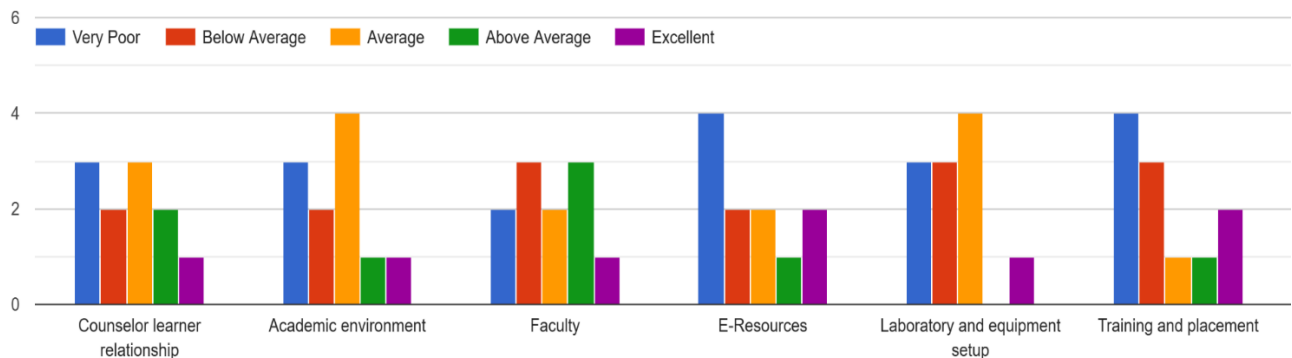
Here are some specific examples of how the alumni feedback form can be used to improve the university:

- Faculty: 70% of students are satisfied with the faculty.

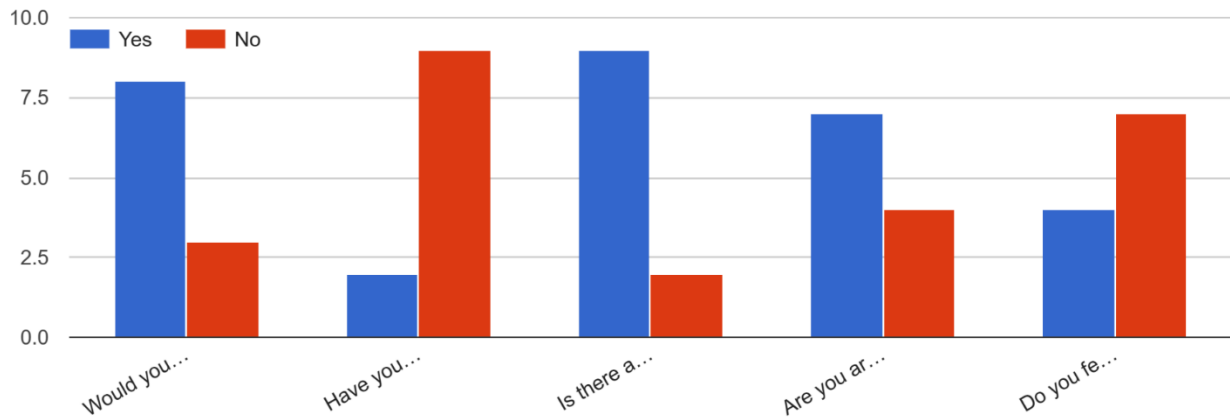
- E-resources: 60% of students are satisfied with the e-resources.
