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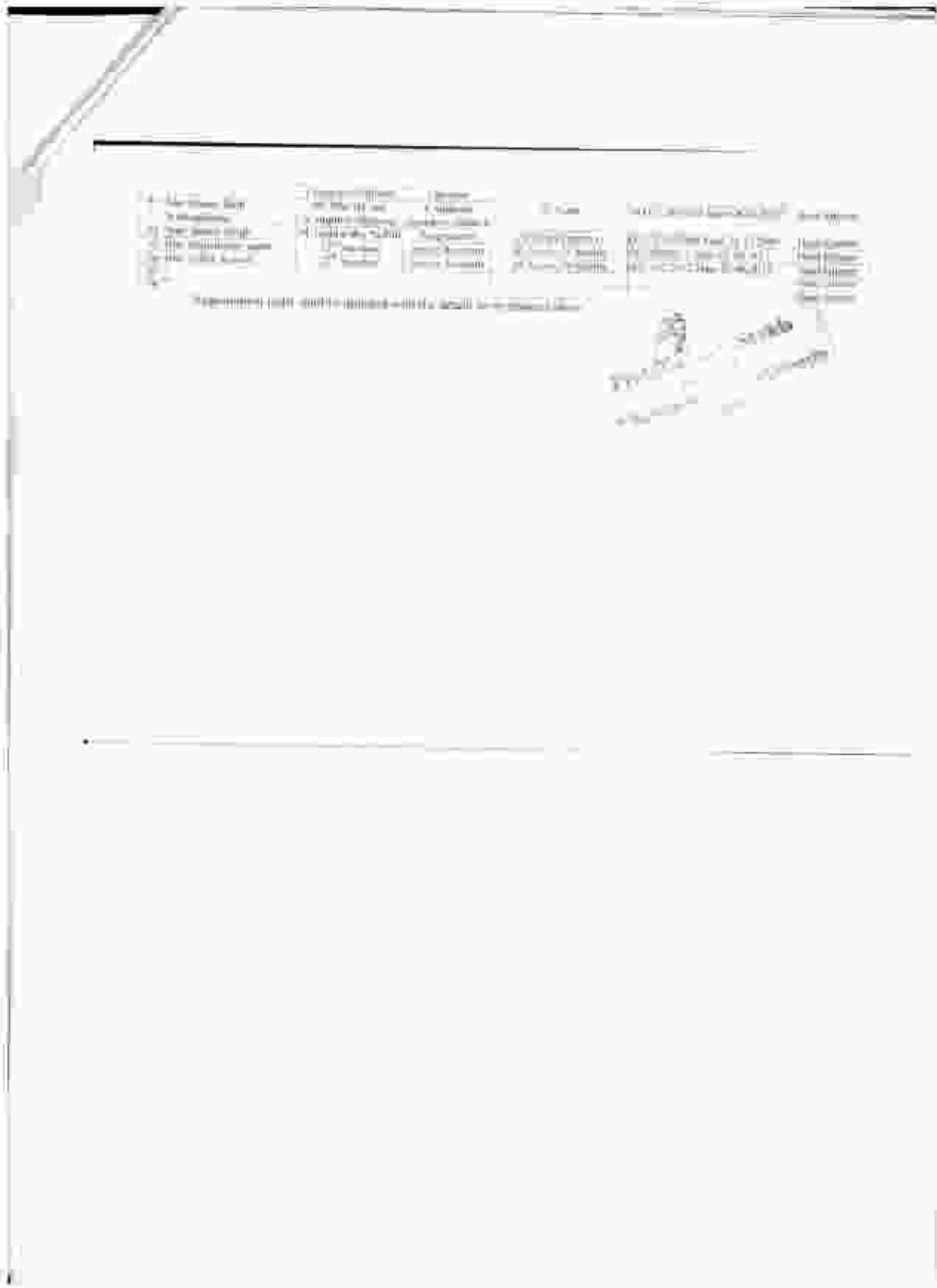

w) The Ministry of HRD's directions prohibiting B.E/ B.Tech through distance mode vide it's letter dated 29.07.2009 shall be adhered to strictly.

x) The programmes in Engineering and Technology e.g. B.E/ B.Tech/ Diploma and courses in Medicines/ Nursing/ Physiotherapy etc. are not allowed and the University will not be offering the same.

xiv) The territorial jurisdiction in respect of University for offering programmes through distance mode will be as per the policy of UGC on territorial jurisdiction and opening of off campuses/centres/study centres as mentioned in the UGC notification No.F.27-1/2012CPP-III, dated 27th June 2013, a copy of which is also posted on the UGC website www.ugc.ac.in/dcb.

xv) The programmes in distance mode will not be offered through franchising arrangement and /or through any private institution /college

xvi) The institution will have necessary infrastructure at its HQ as well as its Study Centres (if any) for conduction of practical work, wherever required.

4. Moreover, the University shall not offer any M.Phil/Ph.D Programme through distance learning mode in compliance to clause 5 of the UGC (Minimum Standard and Procedure for awards of M.Phil./Ph.D Degree), Regulation 2009.

5. The institution's management of the distance education programmes will be open for review and inspection by the UGC. The academic norms of the programmes shall be under monitoring by the concerned regulatory authorities.

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6. It may also be noted that:

- i. If the institution fails to comply with the conditions of recognition for which the Affidavit, as mentioned above has been submitted or if it is found conducting affairs in a manner that leads to deterioration of academic standards, the UGC may withdraw its recognition at any stage. The University will be solely responsible for the same.
- ii. The recognition can be reviewed depending on change of policy with reference to ODL Regulations or otherwise.
- iii. In case any information, documentary evidence submitted/produced by the University/institution is found to be false or fake at a later stage, the recognition of University/institution shall be withdrawn and the University/Institution concerned shall be solely responsible for the all consequences arising out of the same.

There are a number of Open Universities in the country offering various degrees/diplomas through the mode of vocational education. The Open Universities have been established in the country by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature in accordance with the provisions contained in Section 29 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956. These universities are, therefore, empowered to award degrees in terms of Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956.

Authority was earlier issued vide UGC letter No. F-14(2008)009 dated February 1992 mentioning that the Certificates, Diplomas and Degrees awarded by India Grants National Open University units be recognised equivalent to the corresponding awards of the Universities in the country.

Attention is further invited to UGC circular F-14(2008)009-03 dated 28th July 1992 for recognition of degrees and diplomas as well as transfer of credit for courses successfully completed by students between the two types of universities so that the mobility of Students from Open University streams to traditional Universities is ensured without any difficulty.

The UGC has specified the nomenclatures of degrees under Section 22(a) of the UGC Act, 1956 to ensure mandatory requirements viz. minimum essential academic credit required for awarding such degrees. The details of degree nomenclature regarding specification of degrees are given in UGC website www.ugc.ac.in.

Thus, I forward request you to issue the Degree/Diploma /Certificates awarded by the Open Universities in conformity with the UGC nomenclature in Specifications of Degree comparable to the corresponding awards of the traditional Universities in the country.

(Uttar Pradesh Adhiniyam Sankhya 10 of 1999) as passed by the Uttar Pradesh Legislature and assented to by the Governor on March 24, 1999.

THE UTTAR PRADESH RAJARSHI TANDON OPEN UNIVERSITY
ACT, 1999

(U.P.ACT No. 10 OF 1999)

[As passed by the Uttar Pradesh Legislature]

AN

ACT

to provide for the establishment of an Open University in Uttar Pradesh for the introduction and promotion of distance education systems and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

It is hereby enacted in the Fiftieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

CHAPTER - I

Preliminary

1. (1) This Act may be called the Uttar Pradesh Short title and
RAJARSHI TANDON Open University Act, commencement
1999
- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the
State Government may, by notification,
appoint in this behalf.
2. In this Act :- Definitions
- (a) "Academic Council" and "Executive Council"
means respectively and Academic Council,
and the Executive Council of the University:

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- (b) "Board of Recognition" means the Board of Recognition of the University;
- (c) "College" means a college or other academic Institution established or maintained by, or admitted to the Privileges of the University;
- (d) "distance education systems" means the systems of imparting education through any means of communication, such as broadcasting telecasting, correspondence course, seminars, contact programmes or the combination of any two or more of such means;
- (e) "Finance Committee" means the Finance Committee of the University;
- (f) "other backward classes" means the backward classes or citizens specified in Schedule I of the Uttar Pradesh Public Services (Reservation for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes) Act, 1994, as amended from time to time;
- (g) "Planning Board" means the Planning Board of the University;
- (h) "prescribed" means prescribed by the Statutes;
- (i) "school" means a schools of studies of the University;
- (j) "Statutes", "Ordinances" and "Regulations" means, respectively, the Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations of the University;
- (k) "student" means a student of the University, and includes any person who has enrolled

himself for pursuing any course of study of the University;

- (l) "study Centre" means a centre established, maintained or recognized by the university for the purpose of advising, counseling or for rendering any other assistance required by the students;
- (m) "teacher" means a person employed for imparting instruction in the University for giving guidance or rendering assistance to students for pursuing any course of study of the University and includes a Principal or Director of a College;
- (n) "University" means the Uttar Pradesh Rajarshi Tandon Open University established under Section 3.

CHAPTER - II


The University and its Objects

3. (1) There shall be established a University by the name of the Uttar Pradesh Rajarshi Tandon Open University. Establishment and incooperation of the University
- (2) The headquarters of the University shall be at Allahabad and it may establish or maintain colleges or study centre at such other places in the State as it may deem fit.
- (3) The Chancellor, Vice-Chancellor and the members of the Executive Council and the Academic Council for the time being holding office as such in the University, shall constitute a body corporate by the name of the Uttar Pradesh Rajarshi Tandon Open

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University.

4. The University shall promote dissemination of learning and knowledge through distance education systems to a large segment of the population and shall, in organizing its activities, have due regard to the objects specified in the schedule. The Objects of the University
5. The University shall have the following powers, namely :- Powers of the University
- (i) to provide for instruction in such branches of knowledge, technology, vocations and professions as the University may determine from time to time and to make provision for research;
 - (ii) to plan and prescribe courses of study for degrees, diplomas, certificates or for any other purpose;
 - (iii) to hold examinations and confer degrees, diplomas, certificates or other academic distinctions or recognitions on person who have pursued a course of study or conducted research in the manner laid down by the Statutes and Ordinance;
 - (iv) to confer honorary degrees or other distinctions in the manner prescribed;
 - (v) to determine the manner in which distance education in relation to the academic programmes of the University may be organized;
 - (vi) to institute professorships, readerships, lecturerships and other academic positions necessary for imparting instructions or for preparing educational material or for conducting other academic activities,

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including guidance, designing and delivery of course and evaluation of the work done by the students; and to appoint persons to such professorships, readerships, lecturerships and other academic positions.

- (vii) to co-operate with, and seek the co-operation of other universities and institution of higher learning, professional bodies and organisa-tions for such purposes as the University considers necessary;
- (viii) to institute and award fellowships, scholarships, prizes and such other awards for recognition of merit as the University may deem fit.
- (ix) to establish and maintain such regional centres as may be determined by the University from time to time;
- (x) to establish, maintain or recognize Study Centre in the manner prescribed;
- (xi) to provide or the preparation of instructional material, including films, cassettes, tapes, video cassettes and other softwares;
- (xii) to organize the conduct refresher courses, workshop, seminars and other programmes for teachers, lessonwriters, evaluators and other academic staff;
- (xiii) to recognize examinations of or periods of stud, whether in full or part, at other universities, institutions or other places of higher learning as equivalent to examination or periods of study in the University, and to withdraw such recognition at any time;
- (xiv) To make provisions for research and


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development in educational technology and related matters.

- (xv) to create administrative, ministerial and necessary posts and to make appointments thereto;
- (xvi) to receive benefactions donations and gifts and to acquire, hold, maintain and dispose of any property movable or immovable including trust and Government property, for the purposes of the University;
- (xvii) to borrow, with the approval of the State Government, whether on the security of the property of the University or otherwise, money for the purposes of University;
- (xviii) to enter into, carry out, vary or cancel contracts;
- (xix) to demand and receive such fees and other charges as may be laid down by the ordinances;
- (xx) to provide control and maintain discipline among the students and all categories of employees and to lay down the conditions of services of such employees, including their codes of conduct;
- (xxi) to recognize any institution of higher learning or studies for such purposes as the University may determine and to withdraw such recognition;
- (xxii) to appoint either on contract or otherwise Visiting Professors, Emeritus Professors consultants, fellows, scholars, artists, course writers and such other persons who may contribute to the advancement of the objects of the University.


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(xxiii) to recognize persons working in the Universities, institutions or organizations as teachers of the University on such terms and conditions as may be laid down by the Ordinances;

(xxiv) to specify conditions for the admission of students to courses of study of the University which may include examination, evaluation and any other methods of testing.

(xxv) to make arrangements for the promotion of the general health and welfare of the employees;

(xxvi) to confer autonomous status on a college or a regional centre in the manner prescribed;


(xxvii) to admit to its privileges any college in the State subject to such conditions as may be prescribed;

provided that no college shall be so admitted except with the prior approval of the Chancellor;

(xxviii) to do all such acts as may be necessary or incidental to the exercise of all or any of the powers of the University as are necessary and conducive to the promotion of all or any of the Objects of the University;

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law for the time being in force, the University shall in the exercise of its powers have jurisdiction over the whole of Uttar Pradesh. Territorial exercise of powers

7. (1) The University shall be open to persons of either sex irrespective of class or creed, and it shall not be lawful for the University to


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adopt or impose on any person any test whatsoever of religious belief or profession in order to entitle him to be appointed as a teacher of the University, or to hold any other office therein or admitted as a student in the University or to graduate there at, or to enjoy or exercise any privilege thereof.

- (2) Nothing in sub-section (1) shall be deemed to prevent the University from making any special provision for the appointment or admission of women or of persons belonging or admission of women or of persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes or other backward classes.

CHAPTER - III

Inspection and Inquiry


8. (1) The State Government shall have the right to Visitation cause an inspection to be made, by such person or persons as it may direct, of the University or any college or study centre maintained by the University including its buildings, libraries, laboratories, workshops and equipments and also of the examinations, teaching and other work conducted or done by the University or such college or study centre or to cause an inquiry to be made in the like manner in respect of any matter connected with the administration and finances of the University or such college or such centre.


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- (2) Where the State Government decides to cause an inspection or inquiry to be made under sub section (1), it shall inform the University of the same through the Registrar, and any person nominated by the Executive Council may be present at such inspection or inquiry as representative of the University and he shall have the right to be heard as such;

Provided that no legal practitioner shall appear, plead or act on behalf of the University at such inspection or inquiry.


- (3) The person or persons appointed to inspect or inquire under sub-section (1) shall have all the powers of a civil court, while trying a suit under the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, for the purpose of taking evidence on oath and enforcing the attendance of witnesses and compelling production of documents and material objects, and shall be deemed to be a civil court within the meaning of sections 345 and 346 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and any proceedings before him or them shall be deemed to be a judicial proceeding within the meaning of sections 193 and 228 of the Indian Penal Code.
- (4) The State Government shall address the Vice-Chancellor with reference to the result of such inspection or inquiry, and the Vice Chancellor shall communicate to the Executive Council the views of the State Government with such advice as the State Government may offer upon the action to be taken thereon.

The Vice-Chancellor shall then within such

time as the State Government may fix, submit to it a report of the action taken or proposed to be taken by the Executive Council.

- (6) If authorities of the University do not, within a reasonable time, take action to the satisfaction of the State Government, the State Government may, after considering any explanation which such authorities may furnish, issue such directions as it may think fit, and the authorities of the Universities shall comply with such directions.
- (7) The State Government shall send to the Chancellor a copy of every report of an inspection or inquiry caused to be made under sub section (1) and of every communication received from the Vice-Chancellor under sub-section (5) and of every direction issued under sub section (6) and also of every report or information received in respect of compliance or non compliance with such direction.
- (8) Without prejudice to the provisions to sub-section (6), if the Chancellor on consideration of any document or material referred, to in sub section (7) is of opinion that the Executive Council has failed to carry out its functions or has abused its powers, he may, after giving it an opportunity of submitting a written explanation, order that in supersession of the said Executive Council, an ad-hoc Executive Council, consisting of the Vice-Chancellor and such other persons not exceeding ten in number as the chancellor may appoint in that behalf



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including any member of the superseded Executive Council, shall, for such period not exceeding two years as the Chancellor may from time to time specify, exercise and perform all the powers and functions of the Executive Council under this Act.

- (9) Upon an order being made under sub section (8) the term of office of all members of the Executive Council superseded thereby, including ex-officio members, shall cease and all such members shall vacate their offices as such.

CHAPTER – IV
(Officers of the University)

9. The following shall be the officers of the University: Officers of the University

26. Subject to the provisions of this Acts, the Statutes may provide for any matter relating to the University and shall in particular provide for:- Statutes

- (c) the constitution of Executive Council and other authorities of the University, the terms of office of the members of such authorities and the powers and functions that may be exercised and performed by such authorities;
- (d) the appointment of teachers and other employees of the University, their emoluments and other conditions of service;

- (j) the conditions that are required to be fulfilled for admission of the colleges to the privileges of the University;
- (k) all other matters which by this Act are to be, or may be, provided for by the Statutes.
27. (1) The first statutes of the University shall be made by the State Government by notification. Statutes how made

- (6) Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing sub sections the State Government may direct the Executive Council to make provision in the Statutes in respect of any matter specified by it, and if the Executive Council is unable to implement such a direction within sixty days of its receipt, the State Government may, with the assent of the Chancellor, after considering the reasons, if any communicated by the Executive Council for its inability to comply with such direction, make or amend the Statutes

CHAPTER – VII
Annual Report and Accounts

30. (1) The annual report of the University shall be prepared under the direction of the Executive Council which shall include, among other matters, the steps taken by the University towards the fulfillment of its objects. Annual Report
- (2) The annual report so prepared shall be submitted to the Chancellor on or before such date as may be prescribed.
- (3) A copy of the annual report, prepared under sub-section (1) shall also be submitted to the State Government.
31. (1) The annual accounts and the balance sheet of the University shall be prepared under the direction of the Executive Council and shall, once at least every year, and at intervals of not more than fifteen months, be audited by the Directors, Local Funds Accounts, Uttar Pradesh or by such person or persons as the State Government may authorize in this behalf.
- (2) A copy of the annual accounts and the balance sheet together with the audit report thereon shall be submitted to the State Government alongwith the observation, if any, of the Executive Council before the thirtieth of Septembers every year.
- (3) Any observations made by the State Government on the annual accounts shall be brought to the notice of the Executive Council and the views of the Executive Council, if any, on such observations shall be submitted to the State Government.

- (d) Provide an innovative system of University level education, flexible and open, in regard to methods and pace of learning combination of courses eligibility for enrollment age of entry, conduct of examination and operation of the programmes with a view to promote learning and encourage excellence in new fields of knowledge;
- (e) Contribute to the improvement of the educational system by providing a non formal channel complementary to the formal system and encouraging transfer of credits and exchange of teaching staff by making wide use of texts and other software
